

**Red Route**  
**Riverside Ramble**  
**Approx 3.25 miles**

- 1. Follow Green Route to Point 6**
- 2. Continue past Stoke Lock and the Lock Keeper's House, (Stoke Lock was the first lock to be opened on the Wey Navigation in 1653), and follow the tow path to Bowers Lane, (approximately 1 mile).**
- 3. Turn right and take the second turning to enter the Riverside Park. There is an information board here.**
- 4. Follow the path and where it divides (under the electricity pylon) take the left-hand fork, to walk by the lake.**
- 5. Pass the bird identification board.**
- 6. At the duckboards, signed with Post No 9, turn right. Take care as some planks are missing and they can be slippery in wet weather.**
- 7. Rejoin the towpath and turn left.**
- 8. Cross the lock by the bridge.**
- 9. Turn right in front of the house and follow the path to the left, taking the steps to a track.**
- 10. Turn right onto the track and pass Thames Water on the left. Take care as heavy lorries use this track and there is no path on this short section.**
- 11. Go through the second gap in the fence on the left to take a track which passes the Guildford Corporation Club on the right.**
- 12. Take right-hand side of Slyfield Green Road, passing the Red Cross centre to finish back at The Parrot PH.**
